Modern hospitals and health care facilities place multiple patients in close proximity to one another with interconnecting rooms and corridors. Many of those patients will have reduced mobility, medical conditions impacted by smoke, or are receiving treatment or therapy that further delays their timely evacuation in the event of a fire.

When a fire is detected, staff should take measures to rescue any patients in the immediate fire area and activate the emergency response system by calling 9-1-1. With the fire department on its way, staff can take measures to confine the fire by closing the door to the fire area and deploying the hospital-sized SmokeStopper™. This will increase the time available for the evacuation of the immediate fire area and reduce the need for complete evacuation of other areas. Like fire extinguishers, early deployment of the SmokeStopper™ can significantly reduce the severity of a fire in high risk facilities such as hospitals.
